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We are pleased to share a set of platform improvements focused on enhancing usability, clarity, and reliability. Details are provided below.

# 1. Improvements

## 1.1 Mandatory Field Indicators

Mandatory field indicators have been aligned with system validation rules across key areas of the platform. Previously, some required fields did not display an asterisk (\*) despite being enforced during validation. This has now been corrected in the following areas:


- Risk Raise form
- Maintenance module → User / People Management (Create New Person)

### Why this matters:

Missing mandatory indicators during form submission. These fixes ensure the user interface accurately reflects validation requirements, improving clarity and confidence for users.

### How to Navigate:

- Navigate to Raise from the left-hand menu.
- Review the input fields — all mandatory fields are now clearly marked with a red asterisk (\*).
- Attempt to save or proceed without filling required fields to verify accurate validation messages.
- Navigate to Maintenance → User / People Management → Create New Person and verify mandatory field indicators.

## 1.2 Validation Alert Messaging

Incorrect alert messages displayed when saving or progressing while raising a Risk or Issue have been corrected. Previously, users were shown the message “Please enter an event” even though no Event field exists on the Raise form. Validation messages are now accurate and clearly reflect the actual missing or invalid fields.

### Why this matters:

Misleading validation messages made it difficult for users to understand what information was required. This fix provides clear, relevant feedback and reduces unnecessary submission errors.

### How to Navigate:

- Navigate to Raise from the left-hand menu.
- Review the input fields — all mandatory fields are now clearly marked with a red asterisk (\*).
- Attempt to save or proceed without filling required fields to verify accurate validation messages.
- Navigate to Maintenance → User / People Management → Create New Person and verify mandatory field indicators.

## 1.3 People Filter Search Behaviour

### Why This Matters:

### How to Navigate:

- Navigate to **Risk/Issue List** from the left-hand menu.
- Open the **Selection Criteria** dropdown at the top of the list page.
- Use the **Search** section below the search bar.

## 1.4 Maintenance Module – Project Value Information Display

In the Maintenance module’s Organisation Unit creation screen, the display of the Project Value information (i) tooltip has been improved. The explanatory text now appears correctly within the visible screen area instead of rendering below the footer.

### Why This Matters:

Previously, important contextual information was inaccessible, negatively affecting usability. This fix restores proper visibility and improves the overall user interface.

### How to Navigate:

- Navigate to **Maintenance → Organisation Unit Management**.
- Select **Create Organisation Unit**.
- Click the information (i) icon next to **Project Value**.

## 1.5 Risk Register Report – Excel Export Visibility

The Risk Register Excel export formatting has been enhanced to improve the visibility of headers and data:

- In the new Excel format, table headers were not clearly visible due to font colour formatting.

### Why This Matters:

Hidden headers and data reduced the reliability and usability of exported reports. These fixes ensure reports are accurate, readable, and suitable for operational and management use.

### How to Navigate:

- Navigate to **Reporting → Risk Register**.
- Apply required filters and generate the report.
- Export the report using the **new Excel format**.
- Verify that all headers and data are clearly visible in the exported file.

## Summary of Benefits

- **Clear mandatory indicators** — Required fields are now consistently marked across the system.
- **Accurate validation messages** — Users receive clear, relevant feedback when input is missing or incorrect.
- **Improved interface stability** — Filters and information tooltips behave consistently.
