We are pleased to announce a series of improvements aimed at enhancing usability, clarity, and reliability across the platform. Details of the resolved issues are outlined below.

1. Improvements

1.1 Reporting Module – Keyword Selection Persistence

In the Risk Register Report, selected keywords in the *Choose Keywords* modal were not retained after reopening. Previously selected checkbox values appeared unchecked even after saving the selection.

This issue has been corrected, and selected keywords now persist correctly when the modal is reopened.

Why This Matters:

Loss of saved keyword selections caused inconsistent filtering and required users to repeatedly reselect values. This fix ensures reliable selection persistence and improves user efficiency.

How to Navigate:

- Navigate to Reporting → Risk Register
- Open the Choose Keywords modal.
- Select one or more keywords and save.
- Reopen the modal to verify selections are retained.



1.2 Reporting Module – Keyword Display in Search Field

In the Search section, selected keywords were not displayed in the search input field after selection, leaving the field blank.


This issue has been resolved, and selected keywords are now visible in the search input field.

Why This Matters:

The absence of visible selected values made it difficult for users to verify and modify filters. This fix improves transparency and usability of the search functionality.

How to Navigate:

- Navigate to Reporting → Risk Register
- Select keywords using the Choose Keywords option.
- Verify that selected keywords are displayed in the search input field.

1.3 Reporting Module – Incorrect Active Tab Highlight

Within the Reporting module, the incorrect tab was highlighted in the sidebar when navigating between report pages (e.g., Usage Report highlighting Audit Report).

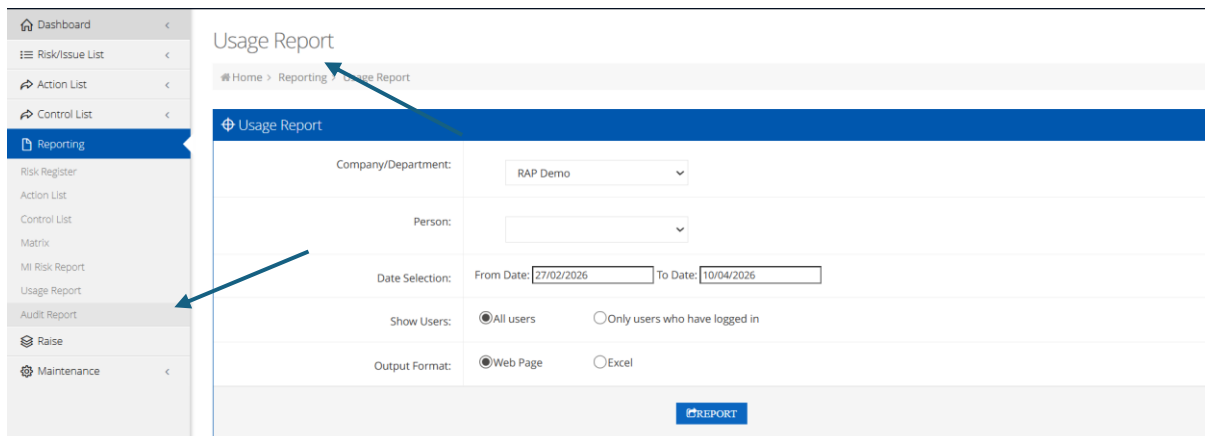
This has been corrected, and the active tab now accurately reflects the selected report.

Why This Matters:

Incorrect tab highlighting caused confusion about the current page and negatively impacted navigation clarity. This fix ensures consistent and accurate visual feedback.

How to Navigate:

- Navigate to the Reporting module
- Open any report tab (e.g., Usage Report).
- Verify that the corresponding tab is correctly highlighted in the sidebar.



1.4 Reporting Module – Report Button Placement Consistency

In the Reporting module, the placement of the *Report* button was inconsistent. In most tabs, the button was positioned outside the form, whilst in the Control tab it was placed inside the form.

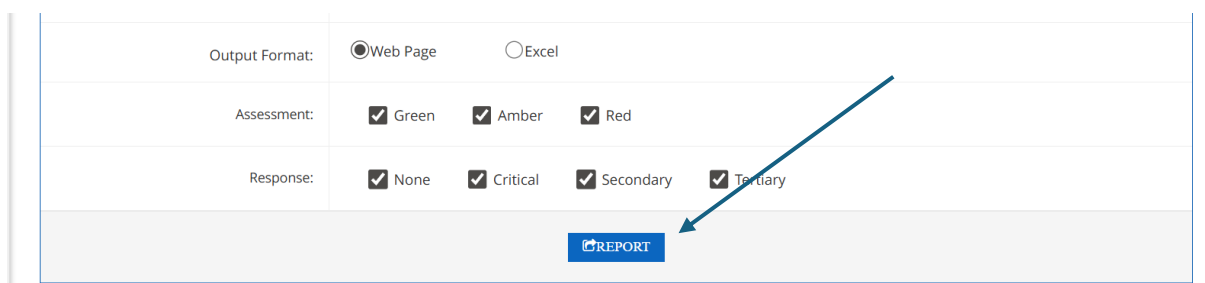
This has been standardised, and the button placement is now consistent across reporting tabs.

Why This Matters:

Inconsistent UI layout affected usability and user experience. This fix ensures a uniform interface and improves ease of use.

How to Navigate:

- Navigate to the Reporting module
- Open any report tab (e.g., Usage Report).
- Verify that the corresponding tab is correctly highlighted in the sidebar.



1.5 Risk Register Report – Status Column Addition

A Status column has been added to the Risk Register Reports in both the Excel export and web-based report view. Previously, the reports did not display the status of each risk item, despite this field being available in other reports (e.g., Control Report).

This ensures consistency across reporting modules and improves visibility of risk progression.

Why This Matters:

The absence of status information limited reporting clarity and required users to refer to other sections. This update ensures consistent data representation and enhances decision-making.

How to Navigate:

- Navigate to Reporting → Risk Register
- Generate the report or export to Excel.
- Verify that the Status column is displayed with correct values.
